## **The Robe, the Ring, and the Sandals**

Luke 15:11-13 Then Jesus said, "A man had two sons. <sup>12</sup> The younger son said to his father, 'Give me my share of the property.' So the father divided the property between his two sons. <sup>13</sup> Then the younger son gathered up all that was his and traveled far away to another country. There he wasted his money in foolish living.

Luke 15:14-16 After he had spent everything, a time came when there was no food anywhere in the country, and the son was poor and hungry. <sup>15</sup> So he got a job with one of the citizens there who sent the son into the fields to feed pigs. <sup>16</sup> The son was so hungry that he wanted to eat the pods the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything.

Luke 15:17-20a When he realized what he was doing, he thought, 'All of my father's servants have plenty of food. But I am here, almost dying with hunger. <sup>18</sup> I will leave and return to my father and say to him, "Father, I have sinned against God and against you. <sup>19</sup> I am no longer worthy to be called your son, but let me be like one of your servants.'" <sup>20</sup> So the son left and went to his father.

Luke 15:20b While the son was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt sorry for his son. So the father ran to him and hugged and kissed him.

Luke 15:21-24 The son said, 'Father, I have sinned against God and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' <sup>22</sup> But the father said to his servants, 'Hurry! Bring the best clothes and put them on him. Also, put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. <sup>23</sup> And get our fat calf and kill it so we can have a feast and celebrate. <sup>24</sup> My son was dead, but now he is alive again! He was lost, but now he is found!' So they began to celebrate.

Robe- Isaiah 61:10a The Lord makes me very happy; all that I am rejoices in my God. He has covered me with clothes of salvation and wrapped me with a coat of goodness...

Ring- Galatians 4:7 So now you are not a slave; you are God's child, and God will give you the blessing he promised, because you are his child.

Sandal- Galatians 5:1 We have freedom now, because Christ made us free. So stand strong. Do not change and go back into the slavery of the law.
