## September 21, 2025 Wait and See What God Will Do

- Isaiah 40:31 But people who wait for the Lord to help them will receive new strength. They will rise up high, as if they have the wings of eagles. They will run and they will not become tired. They will walk and they will not become weak.
- Luke 24:49 I will send you what my Father has promised, but you must stay in Jerusalem until you have received that power from heaven.
